

KEEPING THE LINCOLN WORKING

PLEASE USE AN ALTERNATE ROUTE INTO MANHATTAN WHILE WE MAKE OVERNIGHT REPAIRS TO THE LINCOLN TUNNEL APPROACH (HELIX).

Beginning in August through late summer 2013, we will be conducting “The Helix Fix,” a major rehabilitation of the Lincoln Tunnel New York-bound Route 495 approach (Helix).

All eastbound Lincoln Tunnel approach lanes will be closed and detoured during off-peak overnight hours: **Weekdays 10:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. the next day, Saturdays from 12:01 a.m. to 8 a.m., and Sundays from 1 a.m. to 9 a.m.**

Please expect delays and plan ahead. Call 511 or visit 511NJ.org for the latest travel information. Use alternate routes or mass transit.

The Port Authority is working closely with local police to manage additional Weehawken street traffic resulting from the traffic detour. Additionally, construction-related noise levels will be monitored to ensure work does not exceed noise level limits.

This work will provide a smoother riding surface, reduce delays for periodic maintenance, and improve riding conditions. **Visit TheHelixFix.com for more information.**
