Services

Curbside Pickup Service

- ◆ The Weehawken Free Public Library will be offering Contactless Lobby Pickup Monday through Saturday from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, and on Wednesday until 9:00 pm.
- ◆ To schedule a pickup, Members of the Library must call 201-863-7823 ahead of time to request materials and schedule a pickup time; there will be no walk in service at this time.
- ◆ Pickup will be contactless, and you must bring your physical Weehawken Library Card with you.
- ◆ New Library cards will be issued to Weehawken residents with valid proof of residency through our online form at www.bccls.org.
- ◆ Members are limited to 10 items per visit. DVDs and CDs are limited to 4 items per visit.

- ◆ Weehawken residents who need a computer can call the Library to schedule an appointment. Usage is limited to 45 minutes and printing is available. Normal fees for printing apply and can be paid online through your library account.
- ◆ Residents that need documents printed are able to email the documents to weehcirc@bccls.org. We will place the printouts in the lobby for pickup. Normal fees for printing apply and can be paid online through your library account.
- ◆ Weehawken residents who would like to browse the collection can call the Library to schedule an appointment to use our browsing computer. Usage is limited to 15 minutes.
- ◆ Inter-Library Loan is now available. Weehawken residents can place requests with their library card through the BCCLS web site by visiting www.bccls.org, or by calling the Library.
- ◆ Digital Newspapers may now be accessed on the library computers located on the first floor. Weehawken residents may call the Library to make an appointment to read the digital newspapers. The following are currently being offered: **The Bergen Record, The New York Daily News, The Jersey Journal, and The New York Times.**
- ◆ Digital Subscriptions to Hoopla and Overdrive's Libby are available and free to use with your Weehawken Library card.
