- Digital subscriptions to Hoopla and Overdrive's Libby are free to use with your Weehawken Library card.
- The Library will continue offering contactless lobby pickup as well as contactless printing for those residents who prefer these options. You may email documents to weehcirc@bccls.org. Normal printing fees apply and can be paid online through your library account.
- Any resident needing a new library card can obtain one through our online form at www.bccls.org or by visiting the Library's First Floor Desk. Valid proofs of residency are required.
