WEEHAWKEN CORONAVIRUS UPDATE

- **IMPORTANT** Vaccinations are continuing ! The Township has completed phase 1A (Healthcare, EMS, Police, Fire, and Emergency Personnel). We are currently vaccinating phase 1B, which is “**Individuals at High Risk,**” Individuals aged 65 and older, and individuals ages 18-64 with medical conditions, as defined by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and listed on our Vaccine Registration Website listed here : <https://northhudsonvax.us/weehawken>

Phase 1B vaccines have arrived in very limited supply. Vaccines will be distributed in order of registration. Obviously, it will take several weeks to complete phase 1B. Please be patient. You may still register on the state of New Jersey Vaccination website located at <https://covid19.nj.gov>.

- **IMPORTANT** All testing will continue at the NHCAC test site located on 36th St between Bergenline Ave and Kennedy Blvd in Union City. **Testing is available Monday to Saturday from 9AM to 4PM**
 - **Mondays and Fridays** – Appointments must be made at www.nhnj.us
 - **Tuesdays** - Appointments must be made by calling 201-366-8465
 - **Wednesdays and Saturdays** – Appointments **not required** first-come, first-serve basis.
- **IMPORTANT** the State of New Jersey, the County of Hudson, and the Township of Weehawken are experiencing an increase in COVID positive cases. We all know what precautions to take. Please follow recommendations for mask-wearing, social distancing, and frequently washing/sanitizing your hands.

- **IMPORTANTE** ¡Las vacunaciones han comenzado! El municipio ha completado la fase 1A (Salud, EMS, Policía, Bomberos y personal de emergencia). Ahora estamos comenzando la fase 1B, que es "**Individuos de Alto Riesgo**", individuos de 65 años de edad y mayores, y personas de 18-64 años con condiciones médicas, según lo definido por los Centros para el Control y la Prevención de Enfermedades y enumerado en nuestro sitio web de registro de vacunas enumerado aquí: <https://northhudsonvax.us/weehawken>

Las vacunas para la Fase 1B han llegado en recursos limitados. Las vacunas se distribuirán en orden de registro. Obviamente, se tardará varias semanas en completar la fase 1B.  - **Miércoles y sábado** – No se requiere cita, se atenderán por orden de llegada.

UPDATED WEEHAWKEN CORONAVIRUS GENERAL NOTICES CLOSURES & RESTRICTIONS

Mayor Richard F. Turner, the Township Council, and Township Manager Giovanni D. Ahmad are apprising you of the latest developments in our Township's, County's and State's efforts to curtail the spread of COVID-19 (Coronavirus). The following instructions are a combination of Governor Murphy's requests and Executive Orders and Weehawken's Executive Order.

- Please visit <https://www.weehawkenschools.net> for the latest information on the status of schools and school sports.
- The Weehawken Township State of Emergency remains in effect until further notice. However, the hours of our curfew have changed from **12:00 AM (midnight) to 5:00 AM** and still in effect. Township Manager Giovanni D. Ahmad, the Township Council, and I greatly appreciate your cooperation.
- The Township Municipal Building is open to the public Monday - Friday 10 AM-4 PM admittance will be limited to the lobby only where Employees can assist you there. To enhance our ability to help members of the public, we request that you call and schedule an appointment.
- Governor Phil Murphy has issued an Executive Order which includes restrictions on seating and hours for restaurants, bars, clubs, and lounges.
 - Restaurants, bars, clubs, lounges, and other businesses that serve food or drinks will not be able to operate their indoor premises between 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.
 - Outdoor dining can continue after 10:00 p.m., as can takeout and delivery services.
 - Seating at the physical bar in the indoor areas of bars and restaurants will be prohibited during all operating hours.
- The Governor has updated his order on gatherings:
 - **Outdoor** activities up to **25 people** are allowed. **Indoor** activities up to **10 people**.
- The Weehawken Parking Authority office is located now at 4200 Park Ave, and they are open to the public from on Mondays, Wednesday's and Fridays from 8 AM to 4 PM and on Tuesday's & Thursday's from 8 AM to 7 PM by appointment only. If you have further questions, please call the parking authority at 201-863-1523.
- Weehawken Free Public Library has extended Wednesday hours from 9 AM to 9 PM and is open on Saturdays from 9 AM to 5 PM. The Library is opened Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM– closed on Sunday. For book pick up and limited computer use, and other library services, please call (201) 863-7823 to make an appointment, or visit the township website for more information.
- Gyms and fitness centers may reopen indoor spaces at 25% capacity, so long as they follow required social distancing and other safety protocols. Please visit covid19.nj.gov for more details.
- Governor Murphy has updated his Executive Order Permitting customers to enter businesses With a Limit to their occupancy at 25% of the maximum store capacity.
- Weehawken Municipal Court is open via remote systems. Please call 201-319-6030 Monday–Friday from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM for any Municipal Court questions and matters.
- Governor Murphy has allowed all childcare centers in New Jersey to reopen with strict Guidelines. Please contact your daycare center to see if they are open.
- The Weehawken Township Shuttle bus has been suspended until further notice.

Please keep in mind that events and regulations are changing daily, and sometimes appear to conflict with each other from various levels of government. We will keep you informed as these changes and clarifications take place on a daily basis. Please continue to check on the Township's Facebook and Twitter pages and the Township website for updates. Parks & Playground Procedures & Regulations

The Township Parks & Playground are open in accordance to the State of NJ guidelines

The following restrictions and regulations are in place:

- Playgrounds are limited to 50 percent of total occupancy as determined by the security guard at the playground – excluding employees.
- Playground visitors must wear masks or cloth face coverings, except where the individual is under two years of age and must maintain social distance.
- **Contactless temperatures will be taken at each location for children and adults. No one will be admitted with a temperature of 100.4 F or higher.**
- All playgrounds have been sanitized and will be sanitized routinely with an EPA approved, non-toxic disinfectant.
- Basketball playing is still prohibited
- Parents should limit time to one hour at the playground to help minimize overcrowding

Parents and guardians should use good sense and sound judgment when entering playgrounds. Hand sanitizers and masks will be available at each playground.

Playgrounds

Gregory Park, Pizzuta Park, Louisa Park (Louisa Place entrance only), Waterfront Park playgrounds, Estuary playground, two playgrounds located at Avenue at Port Imperial

Playground Hours: **(7 Days a week) Open from 10AM to Sundown**

Closed from 8AM to 10AM for disinfecting

Weehawken Parks

- Township’s Waterfront Park and the Concert Park adjacent to Chart House pier are open from **10 a.m. to 10 p.m.** These hours are subject to change in the future.

The following is allowed in both parks:

- Picnicking, sitting on benches (you can bring your own lawn chairs), walking.
- **The following is allowed in Waterfront park:**
 - **Jogging will be allowed on the track** on a controlled basis.
 - Walking dogs and biking on walkways and paths only
 - Parking will be limited to Weehawken residents only.
 - The soccer field, and softball field are open only organized township events.
 - Tennis Courts are open 9am to 9pm – Reservations required call recreation office at 201-319-6061
 - Parking will be limited to Weehawken residents only.

- Hamilton Plaza – Open 10AM to 10PM
- Reservoir Park – Open Monday – Friday 6 a.m. to Sundown / Saturday -Sunday 7 a.m. to Sundown Jogging not allowed at this time

The following applies to all parks and playgrounds:

- Anyone entering must be wearing a mask or face covering, which must be in place the entire time you in the park. Everyone must practice social distancing.
