WEEHAWKEN CORONAVIRUS UPDATE & BACK TO NORMAL ROLL OUT

- **IMPORTANT** As we return to normalcy and the Governor's State of Emergency due to expire at the end of this week. The Township of Weehawken will issue our Coronavirus updates and notices once a week on Wednesdays. The Township will issue special notifications as needed.
- Governor Murphy Signs Executive Order lifting the State of Emergency. The Executive order will reduce the 140 Executive Orders to 14 Executive Orders. Some of the most significant of the remaining Executive Orders are as follows:
 - Moratorium on evictions
 - Moratorium on insurance companies canceling policies for those who don't pay
 - Moratorium on utility shutoffs for those who don't pay
 - Protocols at summer youth camps
 - Shielding federal stimulus payments from wage garnishment

The Weehawken State of Emergency anticipated to expire at the same as the New Jersey State of Emergency at the end of this week.

IMPORTANT Vaccinations are continuing. The Township's vaccination rate is currently at **71%**. **We can do better! We must do better! Herd Immunity requires 70-80% of the adult population to be vaccinated.** Anyone aged 18 and over are eligible and do not need to meet any medical conditions or criteria. We will also be able to vaccinate **minors who are 12 and older** (at this time, the Pfizer Vaccine is the only vaccine allowed for minors. Minors must have parental/guardian consent). - Governor Murphy signed Executive Order allowing the following changes that went into effect on Friday, May 28, 2021:
 - Indoor & outdoor restrictions have been lifted with the following exceptions:
 - **Businesses and entities overseeing indoor spaces will continue to have the ability to require masking for employees, customers, and/or guests and require social distancing should they choose.**
 - Per CDC guidance, masks will continue to be required in health care settings, including long-term care facilities and office-based settings, correctional facilities, homeless shelters, and on planes, buses, trains, and other forms of public transportation, as well as transportation hubs such as airports and stations.
 - Additionally, also per CDC guidance, child care centers and facilities, youth summer camps, and public, private, and parochial preschool program premises and elementary and secondary schools, including charter and renaissance schools, are not affected by this announcement and continue to be governed by existing requirements.
- All restaurants in Weehawken can operate under pre-COVID hours (some COVID restrictions may still be place).
- **IMPORTANT** All testing will continue at the Union City/Weehawken test site located on 36th St between Bergenline Ave and Kennedy Blvd in Union City. **Testing is available Monday to Saturday.**
 - **Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays** – Appointments **not required** first-come, first-serve basis 9 AM to 4 PM.
 - **Wednesdays and Saturdays** – Appointments **not required** first-come, first-serve basis 9 AM to 2 PM.
- **Great News** Due to the Vaccinations, the number of positive cases are decreasing, and we can do even better to protect ourselves, our families, and our community.

ACTUALIZACIÓN DEL CORONAVIRUS EN WEEHAWKEN & INTRODUCCIÓN AL REGRESO A LA NORMALIDAD

- **IMPORTANTE** A medida que regresemos a la normalidad y el estado de emergencia del gobernador debido a expirar el fin de esta semana. El municipio de Weehawken emitirá nuestras actualizaciones y avisos de Coronavirus una vez a la semana los miércoles. El municipio emitirá notificaciones especiales según sea necesario.
- El Gobernador Murphy firma la Orden Ejecutiva levantando el Estado de Emergencia. La Orden Ejecutiva reducirá las Órdenes Ejecutivas de 140 a 14 Órdenes Ejecutivas. Algunas de las órdenes ejecutivas más importantes son las siguientes:
 - Moratoria en los desalojos
 - Moratoria en las compañías de seguros que cancelan pólizas para aquellos que no pagan
 - Moratoria en los cortes de servicios públicos para aquellos que no pagan
 - Protocolos en los campamentos juveniles de Verano
 - Proteger los pagos federales de estímulo del embargo de salarios
- Se prevé que el Estado de Emergencia de Weehawken expire al mismo tiempo que el Estado de Emergencia de Nueva Jersey en 30 días
- **IMPORTANTE** Las vacunaciones continúan La tasa de vacunación del municipio es actualmente del **71%**. **¡Podemos hacerlo mejor! ¡Debemos hacerlo mejor! La inmunidad de rebaño requiere que el 70-80% de la población adulta sea vacunada.** Mayores de 18 años son elegibles y no necesitan cumplir con ninguna condición o criterio médico. También podremos vacunar a **menores de 12 años o más** (en este momento, la Vacuna de Pfizer es la única vacuna permitida para menores de edad). Los menores deben contar con el consentimiento de los padres/tutores). Para más conveniencia, puede llamar al 201-319-6005 o visitar <https://northhudsonvax.us/weehawken> para registrarse.
- El gobernador Murphy firmó una orden ejecutiva que permitió los siguientes cambios que entrarán en vigencia el viernes 28 de mayo de 2021:
 - Restricciones adentro y afuera han sido descontinuadas con las siguientes excepciones:
 - Los negocios y entidades que supervisan los espacios interiores continuarán teniendo la capacidad de exigir el enmascaramiento de los empleados, clientes y / o invitados y requerirán el distanciamiento social si así lo desean.
 - Según la orientación de los CDC, se seguirán necesitando mascarillas en los entornos de atención médica, incluidos los centros de atención a largo plazo y los entornos de oficina, las instalaciones correccionales, los refugios para personas sin hogar, y en aviones, autobuses, trenes y otras formas de transporte público, así como centros de transporte como aeropuertos y estaciones.
 - Además, según la orientación de los CDC, los centros e instalaciones de cuidado infantil, los campamentos de verano para jóvenes y los locales públicos, privados y parroquiales del programa preescolar y las escuelas primarias y secundarias, incluidas las escuelas chárter y renacentistas, no se ven afectados por este anuncio y siguen regidos por los requisitos existentes.
- Todos los restaurantes en Weehawken pueden operar bajo las horas pre-COVID (algunas restricciones covid todavía pueden estar en lugar).
- **IMPORTANTE** Todas las pruebas continuarán en el sitio de pruebas de Union City/Weehawken ubicado en la Calle 36 entre Bergenline Ave y Kennedy Blvd en Union City. **Las pruebas están disponibles de lunes a sábado.**
 - **Lunes, martes, jueves y viernes** – **No se requieren citas**, por orden de llegada de 9 AM a 4 PM.
 - **Miércoles y sábado** – **No se requieren citas**, por orden de llegada de 9 AM a 2 PM.
- **Buenas Noticias** Debido a las vacunas, el número de casos positivos está disminuyendo, y podemos hacerlo aún mejor para protegernos a nosotros mismos, a nuestras familias y a nuestra comunidad.

Mayor Richard F. Turner, the Township Council, and Township Manager Giovanni D. Ahmad are apprising you of the latest developments in our Township's, County's and State's efforts to curtail the spread of COVID-19 (Coronavirus). The following instructions are a combination of Governor Murphy's requests and Executive Orders and Weehawken's Executive Order.

- **IMPORTANT** As we return to normalcy and most of the Governor's State of Emergency have expired. The Township of Weehawken will issue our Coronavirus updates and notices once a week on Wednesdays. The Township will issue special notifications as needed.
- Please visit <https://www.weehawkenschools.net> for the latest information on the status of schools and school sports.
- The Governor has updated his order on gatherings:
 - There is no capacity limit for outdoor gatherings.
 - **General indoor gatherings** limits have been lifted please abide by general fire & safety capacity rules, entities overseeing indoor spaces can continue to require social distancing should they choose.
- Gyms and fitness centers may reopen at regular capacity but their management may continue to require social distancing should they choose. Please visit [covid19.nj.gov](https://www.covid19.nj.gov) for more details.
- Weehawken Municipal Court is open via remote systems. Please call 201-319-6030 Monday–Friday from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM for any Municipal Court questions and matters.
- Governor Murphy has allowed all childcare centers in New Jersey to reopen with strict Guidelines. Please contact your daycare center to see if they are open.
- The Weehawken Township Shuttle bus has been suspended until further notice.

Please keep in mind that events and regulations are changing daily, and sometimes appear to conflict with each other from various levels of government. Playgrounds

Playground Summer Hours: **7 Days a week from 8 AM to 8 PM** (Sprinklers Hours 10 AM to 7 PM)

Weehawken Parks

- Township's Waterfront Park and the Lincoln Harbor Park adjacent to Chart House pier are open from **7 AM to 10 PM**; these hours are subject to change in the future.

The following is allowed in both parks:

- You can bring your lawn chairs.
- Walking dogs and biking on walkways and paths only.

- **The following is allowed in Lincoln Harbor Park:**

- Picknicking

The following is allowed in Waterfront park:

- Tennis Courts are open 8 AM to 10 PM (last reservation 9 PM) – Reservations are required; please call the recreation office at 201-319-6061

- Weehawken Waterfront Pier – Open 7 AM to 12 AM
- Hamilton Plaza – Open 7AM to 12AM
- Reservoir Park – Open 7 AM to 9 PM
