DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

The Township of Weehawken is soliciting bids for the award of a contract in connection with its Fall 2015 Tree Planting Program. The Contract will be for the sale, delivery and planting of Eighty-One (81) curbside trees, of the caliper size and variety or species, and in the locations throughout the Township of Weehawken, as set forth in EXHIBIT A to these Specifications (consisting of four (4) pages).

In the event any of the listed species is unavailable to the bidder, the bidder may, if you so choose, list the name of another species which is available and which the bidder feels would be a suitable substitute species. These species may, but need not, be considered by the Township, in its discretion, in connection with its selection of the successful bid.

All trees are to be grown in a climate similar to that of New Jersey. All trees shall be single leader, high-branched, street trees, insect and disease free and with firm root balls. All trees are to be grown and dug in accordance with standards of the American Association of Nurseryman (AAN).

The trees must be bagged and burlapped. The contractor will be required to have each and every designated tree delivered to, and planted in, its specified planting site. The contractor will be required to make sidewalk cuts at certain locations and in others use existing tree pits, all as shown in these Specifications. When sidewalk cuts are to be made, they shall have an approximate opening of 48" x 48" in order to accommodate the root ball, where space permits, and otherwise no smaller than 36" x 36" unless specifically indicated otherwise in these Specifications. The sidewalk cuts are to be made with a blade capable of cutting through concrete and leaving a clean edge, with no breaks or jagged edges, nor any damage to the surrounding sidewalk or curb. Water shall be used on the blade in order to reduce dust. Automobiles in the area shall be protected with tarps.

Planting shall be done as indicated herein, and in accordance with the most current Arboricultural standards.

1. All material shall conform to the guidelines established by the current American Standard Nursery Stock, published by the AAN.
2. Cut and remove burlap, rope and wire basket from top and side of root ball. Remove all synthetic material. Remove only dead or damaged branches.
3. The tree trunk flare and top of root ball should be set at grade in well-drained soil, up to 2" higher than grade in poorly drained soils. Set ball on undisturbed soil to prevent settling.
4. All tree pit locations are to be backfilled with the removed soil, if usable, plus additional clean, quality topsoil mixture, if necessary, and the old, unusable backfill is to be removed and properly discarded.
5. The Contractor is responsible for thoroughly watering and mulching the tree at the time of initial planting. All trees will be staked and mulched with uncolored cedar or hardwood mulch up to 2", keeping mulch away from trunk base.

Trees shall be guaranteed for the period of one (1) year from the time of planting.

All debris from a site must be removed and discarded in a lawful manner by the contractor, including but not be limited to the cut concrete and removed soil.

The Contractor will supply a handout to the homeowner as to the care and maintenance of his/her newly planted tree(s).

Work is to be completed during the Fall of 2015, immediately following the removal of any trees at the listed locations that are replacements for existing trees. The Contractor will be notified by the Township approximately seven (7) calendar days in advance of the conclusion of the Tree Removal Program. The Contractor will be responsible for notifying the Township's landscape consultant, Lauren Sherman (201-232-2319 or 201-319-6050), at least two (2) business days before coming to the Township to perform the necessary sidewalk cuts.

Contractor is Responsible for Contacting the Underground Plant Location Service (New Jersey ONE-CALL) and coordinating and obtaining utility mark-outs.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

All bidders and all bidders who are negotiating for a contract as a precondition to entering into a valid and binding procurement or service contract with the Township, are required to submit to the Township, prior to or at the time the contract is submitted for signing by the Township (in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-4.3 promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to P.L. 1975, c. 127), one of the following three documents:

- (i) Appropriate evidence that the bidder is operating under an existing federally approved or sanctioned affirmative action program; or
- (ii) A certificate of employee information report approval issued in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-4; and
- (iii) An initial employee information report consisting of forms provided by the affirmative action office and completed by the Bidder in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-4.

If written notice of the acceptance of this Bid is mailed, telegraphed, telecopied or otherwise delivered to the Undersigned within sixty (60) days after the date of opening of the Bid, or any time thereafter before this Bid is withdrawn, the Undersigned will, within five (5) days after receipt of same, execute and deliver to the Township an acknowledgment of the Township's Purchase Order for the goods, materials, equipment, systems, services, labor and all other items described in the Bidding Documents and Bid, as accepted, in standard form and acceptable to the Township. All required work thereunder shall be completed by the Contractor within twenty-eight (28) calendar days after receipt by the Contractor of written notice of the acceptance of its Bid by the Township (the Completion Date). The Bidder further agrees to pay as liquidated damages the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each consecutive calendar day that required work remains incomplete beyond the Completion Date.

The Undersigned affirmatively declares that the Bidder has fully reviewed the specifications and has become completely familiar with all of the conditions which surround and may affect the cost of this contract.

With regard to the above Bid, the Undersigned agrees that these sums represent the entire cost of the contract and agrees to absorb all increases in labor rates, material prices and all other associated costs and expenses affecting this Contract.
